The purpose of this translated information sheet is to assist your comprehension. You MUST refer to the German version for current amounts (in euros).

Exemption from prescription charges valid from 1 January 2015

Dear Sir/Madam

Under certain conditions, people needing a prescription do not have to pay prescription charges. Except in cases regulated by law, the exemption must be submitted to the district health insurance fund (*Gebietskrankenkasse*).

The following are exempt from prescription charges and do not have to make an application:

- Recipients of cash benefits who already have a specific social need for protection when this benefit is awarded (e.g. pension with a cost-of-living allowance – there are special regulations for people with a farm annuity (*Ausgedinge*)).
- Patients with notifiable diseases (the exemption is solely for medicines for treating the notifiable disease and not for treating complications).
- People doing community service (*Zivildienst*) and their dependants.

The following are exempt from prescription charges and have to make an application:

- Those whose monthly net income does not exceed the following amounts:
**€ 872,31 for single people and
€ 1.307,89 for married couples or partners.**
- People who due to sickness or infirmity provide evidence of above average outgoings and whose monthly net income does not exceed the following amounts:
**€ 1.003,16 for single persons and
€ 1.504,07 for married couples or partners.**
- The above amounts increase by **€ 134,59** for every unprovided-for child.

- There are different regulations for people who have a farm annuity (*Ausgedinge*).
- If there are people with their own incomes living together with the insured person, we have to consider such people as well.
- If your application is approved, the exemption from prescription charges will be stored electronically and can be viewed by your doctor using your e-Card. For the doctor, this means that the prescriptions needed must be marked “exempt from prescription charges”.
